Marquette Online Master in Management Program

HOW MUCH TIME PER WEEK SHOULD I BE SPENDING ON COURSE WORK?

Students, in general, can expect to spend about 3-4 hours per week for each credit for which they are enrolled. For example, for a typical 3-credit course you can expect to spend approximately 9-12 hours per week.

HOW MANY CLASSES AM I TAKING PER TERM?

Students will take two classes per term.

HOW MANY CREDITS PER HOUR IS EACH COURSE? HOW MANY DO I NEED TO GRADUATE?

Courses are either 1.5 or 3 credits.

To graduate with the MiM, students must complete 21 core credits, and 9 credits worth of electives.

Yes, Google Chrome is the preferred browser.

WILL I HAVE THE SAME ACCESS TO ON-CAMPUS RESOURCES AS AN ONLINE STUDENT?

HOW MANY CREDITS WILL BE TRANSFERRED INTO MY PROGRAM?

The academic department can review transcripts for potential transfer of credit. Each transferred course must have been taken at the graduate level for graduate credit at Marquette University or another AACSB-accredited institution. Official transcripts must be on file at the Graduate School of Management. Only courses in which the student has earned a grade of "B" (3.0) or better may be transferred. Credits will not be transferred until the student has successfully completed 6 or more credits as a degree-status student in a master's program at Marquette. A maximum of 6 credits may be transferred to the BUAD, ACCO and ECON programs, etc. A separate form must be completed for each institution from which transfer of credit is requested: <https://www.marquette.edu/business/graduate/documents/TransferofCreditRequest.pdf>
