FUNDING YOUR EDUCATION Financial Aid

To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you will need:

- Your Social Security Number or your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically

If you are a dependent student, then you also need most of the above information for your parent(s).

HOW DO I GET MY MONEY?

The financial aid staff at your college will explain exactly how and when your aid will be paid out. They will also tell you whether you need to fill out any more paperwork or meet other requirements. For instance, if you're receiving a federal student loan for the first time, you should expect to be required to sign a promissory note and go through entrance counseling. Be sure to keep in touch with your school's financial aid office so that you understand the whole process of receiving your aid.
